


Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (2023 = 100) March 2025

Month-on-Month Change



The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index fell 2.2% in March 2025, following the 0.1% decrease in February 2025. The Oil index dropped 4.6%, continuing the 2.2% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index fell 1.8% in March 2025, reversing the 0.3% increase in February 2025.

The decline in the Non-oil index was mainly driven by the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, led by lower prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Chemicals & Chemical Products, Food & Live Animals, Crude Materials and Animal & Vegetable Oils indices. The decreases were partially moderated by gains in the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles index.

The Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index rose 3.3% in March 2025 from a year ago, extending the 6.0% increase in February 2025. The Oil index dipped 10.9% while the Non-oil index gained 6.0%.


The increase in the Non-oil index was due to the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, attributed to higher prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Food & Live Animals, Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Crude Materials and Animal & Vegetable Oils indices. The increases were partially offset by declines in the Chemicals & Chemical Products, Manufactured Goods and Beverages & Tobacco indices.

The Domestic Supply Price Index fell 1.9% in March 2025, following the 0.3% decrease in February 2025. The Oil index dropped 3.6%, extending the 1.5% decrease in the previous month. The Non-oil index fell 1.4% in March 2025, after the 0.1% increase in February 2025.

The decrease in the Non-oil index was mainly driven by the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, attributed to lower prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Chemicals & Chemical Products, Manufactured Goods, Animal & Vegetable Oils and Beverages & Tobacco indices. The decreases were partially offset by increases in the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Crude Materials and Food & Live Animals indices.

The Domestic Supply Price Index rose 3.9% in March 2025 from a year ago, extending the 5.5% increase in February 2025. The Oil index dipped 10.7% while the Non-oil index rose 9.3%.

The increase in the Non-oil index was primarily led by the Machinery & Transport Equipment index, contributed by higher prices of electrical machinery apparatus, as well as the Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, Food & Live Animals, Animal & Vegetable Oils, Crude Materials and Beverages & Tobacco indices. The increases were partially moderated by decreases in the Chemicals & Chemical Products and Manufactured Goods indices.

Technical Note

The **Singapore Manufactured Products Price Index (SMPPI)** monitors price changes of locally manufactured commodities. The weights of the index are derived from the distribution of local production by commodity in 2023. Ex-factory prices are obtained from principal manufacturers of the items concerned.

The **Domestic Supply Price Index (DSPI)** is designed to measure the changes in the price level of either goods manufactured locally or imported, which are retained for use in the domestic economy by the government, business or household sectors. For imported products, the prices refer to those paid by importers in bringing the goods into Singapore, commonly referred to as c.i.f. prices. In the case of Singapore manufactured products, the quotations used are ex-factory prices. The weight for each commodity item is proportional to the value of its total supply or availability in the domestic market in 2023.

Index Formula

The 2023-based series is compiled using the 'modified Laspeyres' formula where the weight reference period of 2022 preceded the price reference period of 2023. The geometric mean formula has been adopted in the computation of unweighted elementary aggregate price indices. The arithmetic mean formula is applied in compiling indices at higher levels of aggregation where weights of specific sub-indices are available.

Measurement of Changes in Price Indices

Change over previous month compares the index of the month with that of the preceding month. Such comparisons measure the change in the price index between two consecutive months. They serve as useful short-term indicators of the price movements.

Change over same period of previous year measures change in the index over a twelve-month period. Such comparisons compare the movement in the price index between similar months in two consecutive years.

Linking the Old 2018-Based Price Index Series to the New 2023-Based Price Index Series

The SMPPI and DSPI have been rebased from base year 2018 to base year 2023. To facilitate comparison of the historical price indices across base years, the old 2018-based series are linked to the new 2023-based series by re-scaling them via a Linked Coefficient. The Linked Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2018-based index in 2023.

Example: Linking the old Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPI prior to 2023, to the 2023-based Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)

Year	Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)	Iron & Steel Index (2023=100)	Linked Coefficient

1) Calculate the linked coefficient

2) Re-scaling the old series to the 2023-based series using the Linked Coefficient

Rescaling the 2023-Based Index Series to Previous Years

To continue the old 2018-based index series going forward in time, re-scale the new 2023-based index series to the old base year 2018 level, via a Rescaling Coefficient. The Rescaling Coefficient is the ratio of the annual 2023-based index in 2023 to the annual 2023-based index in 2018.

Example: Rescaling the new 2023-based Iron & Steel Index series for SMPPI to the 2018-based Iron & Steel Index (2018=100)

1) Calculate the rescaling coefficient

2) Re-scaling the new series to the 2018-based series using the Rescaling Coefficient

Index Revision


The indices may be revised when late returns and amendments received from respondents are incorporated.


